Intermittent full closures of I-75 Thursday night for utility work on modernization project in Oakland County

Fast facts:

- Intermittent full freeway and service drive closures will start at 11:30 p.m. Thursday, March 19.
- The intermittent closures will occur between 9 Mile and John R. roads.
- This utility work is scheduled to be completed by 3 a.m. Friday, March 20.

March 17, 2020 -- Contracting crews will be relocating utility lines above I-75 starting at 11:30 p.m. Thursday, March 19. In order to conduct this work safely, both directions of I-75 will be closed intermittently between 9 Mile and John R. roads. The relocation work is scheduled to be completed by 3 a.m. Friday, March 20.

In addition, the northbound and southbound service drives will be intermittently closed. The limits and times are identical to the freeway work.
